

REMEMBERING The atomic bombing of HIROSHIMA 6th August 1945 and Nagasaki 9th August 1945



Many thousands were killed instantly, many more died later from multiple injuries especially burns, and even more later many suffered from diseases such as cancer and genetic damage. Vast numbers of plants and animals were destroyed or mutated by the effect of the bombs.

Seventy three years later the nuclear threat remains.
